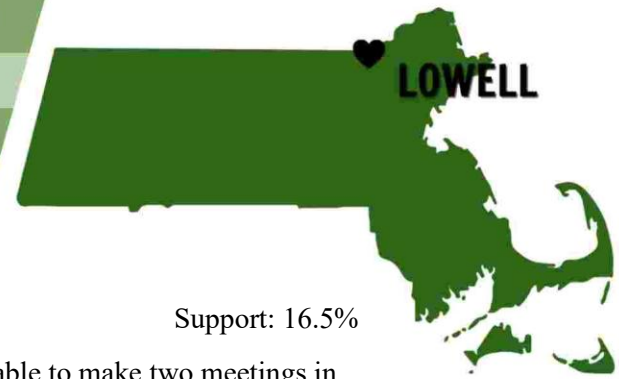

**Michigan.** We drove from the Carter Family Reunion in Colorado to Michigan for some meetings in the Ann Arbor area, including the church pastored by our Assistant Pastor's father, Fellowship Baptist Church of Whitmore Lake. It was wonderful to meet their church and family, then have good reports back to our own Assistant Pastor. The traffic in the area was hectic, but God kept us safe.

**Home!** After leaving Michigan, we travelled back to our home base in West Tennessee for the first time since June. We were able to fellowship with Pastor Freeman Weems of our sending church one more time before he retires next month. We were also encouraged by our sending church, First Baptist Church of Atoka. Their love and care for us has been a push forward into deputation, knowing that our backs are covered, so to speak. I also made sure to get an alignment, but the rear brakes were worn down, as well, so we were in need of new brake pads and rotors. we were able to make two meetings in Woodstock and Baltimore, as well as make new connections with pastors in the Winchester area.

**Upcoming.** We will be traveling to New York City shortly, where we will visit Way of the Cross Baptist Church, pastored by Brother Alan Bradley. He is a church-planter supported by our sending church, and we are excited to assist in their discipleship and growth. After NYC, we will be in New Hampshire and Massachusetts for the rest of September and into October. Pray for our safe travels and for Joseph's sleep schedule.

**Souls.** While we travel, we meet a lot of people in gas stations, restaurants, rest stops, etc. We try to take the opportunity to at least hand people tracts with the Gospel. We do not know their names most of the time, but pray for those that receive a presentation of the Gospel while we travel.

**Support Update.** Last month, I reported that our support had slowed, and we are currently in a similar position; however, it is beginning to pick up pace. We have had multiple pastors contact us recently promising church support, so we are in hopeful anticipation for those partnerships. Our goal is to be a blessing in the churches we visit, then we pray that God will provide for us to get to the field He has called us to. We are also expecting support to pick up as we get into the fall months. Continue to pray for Lowell, MA, as many are dying without the hope of the Gospel.
